

This short book offers hope and joy for anyone with Alzheimer's. Its single-minded focus is on improving the quality of life of anyone living with dementia. Fenker argues that our negative approaches to Alzheimer's with concepts such as "the longest day" and "the long goodbye" harm individuals with the disease by biasing their expectations (and those of their caregivers) and depriving them of many positive moments. In Chapter 2 he suggests that "a cure is available now" for this bad attitude and then describes how we might accomplish this goal.

The book offers a dozen practical approaches to add joy and create opportunities to live a complete life beginning with making this "choice" in Chapter 1, starting a bucket list and focusing NOW on decisions that cannot be made at a later time. Chapters on Communication, Personhood, "What Makes Life Worth Living," Being the "Hero" in the Alzheimer's journey, Comic Relief and others add many positive ideas and practical approaches.

Fenker also introduces the concept of "Companion Mind" called MindPartner™ that stores a person's life history and then makes it accessible through the Alzheimer's journey.
